**Job Overview:** Barry Town United is seeking a motivated and professional Sports Therapist or Physiotherapist to support the health, wellbeing and performance of the First Team squad.

The successful candidate will provide injury assessment, treatment, rehabilitation and pitch-side medical support during training sessions and matchdays. Working closely with the coaching staff and players, you will play a key role in maintaining player availability and supporting performance throughout the season.



# Key Responsibilities

## Medical Support

- Provide pitch-side medical cover at first-team training sessions and fixtures.
- Assess, diagnose and treat injuries sustained during training and matches.
- Deliver immediate first aid and emergency care where required.
- Maintain medical equipment and first aid supplies.

## Injury Management & Rehabilitation

- Design and implement individual rehabilitation programmes.
- Monitor player recovery and provide return-to-play recommendations.
- Deliver injury prevention strategies and player education.
- Work closely with coaching staff regarding player fitness and availability.

## Player Welfare & Performance

- Support player wellbeing and physical readiness throughout the season.
- Assist with pre-match preparation, recovery protocols and post-match treatments.
- Promote best practice in injury prevention, recovery and performance management.

## Administration & Communication

- Maintain accurate and confidential medical records.
- Communicate effectively with players, coaches and club officials.
- Prepare injury updates and reports for the management team when required.
- Ensure compliance with safeguarding and club welfare policies.
- Work closely with Academy Medical staff to ensure transparency across the club pathway

## Additional Responsibilities

- Attend club meetings where appropriate.
- Undertake relevant CPD to maintain professional standards.
- Carry out any other reasonable duties associated with the role.
